Sermon Title: CONFESSION AND PRAYER

Date: November 3, 2024 - James 5:16-18

Central Idea: The cure for sickness is in personal confession and prayerful concern. Are you practicing confession and concern?

Introduction: James has been telling us that all of life is to be bathed in prayer: prayers when we are down, prayers of song when we are up, prayers for the sick, and now, prayers for each other. A mutual concern for one another is the way to combat sickness, discouragement, and downfall.
